These two organizations have been seeing our most vulnerable population for years, without missing an evening or an opportunity to bring much-needed medical care to those that need it most. We are able to do this with the assistance of our host location, Ramona Tire of Palm Desert, who has graciously partnered with our groups to utilize their parking lots for set-up. A couple of new additions to the group are a hair stylist and the Cal State University San Bernardino Nursing Street Medicine Program that offers additional blood pressure checks, glucose monitoring and other circulatory and wound care plus foot soaks.

During our time at Ramona Tire, we witnessed many beautiful miracles. We have been able to serve hot showers and hygiene supplies to many different people from many different places. We talked to Johnny, a young man that walked to Coachella Valley from

He now is one of our regulars. Being a man of few words, he has opened up to us with his infectious smiles and is learning to trust us and others more. This is a huge step for him, and we love it. During the heat of the summer, we were told that two of our patrons had passed away, partly from heat exhaustion and exposure. Since then, eight of our guests have gotten off the street and into either recovery programs or housing. With another four individuals seeking counseling and looking into a recovery program of their own, the message of hope and that of a better future is starting to take root.

Our average number of patrons is about a dozen or so men and women requesting showers with another handful

getting much-needed hygiene supplies and clothing. The time we spend with our patrons and guests is life changing. One evening, we stayed an extra hour so we could continue talking with a 16-year-old runaway. She had been on the streets for only a day and a half, but it was obvious that she realized her mistake. We provided a safe place and a safe way to consider what she needed most. In the end, we were able to reunite her with her father and brother and witness her going home. All while a human trafficker was circling the block waiting and watching. We at Overflow 9:12 offer showers, hygiene and basic necessities. But being able to build lasting relationships and speak with so many hurting people about hope, grace and mercy is the real gift. The gift that keeps us going back month after month.
